

As those of you who attend the meetings regularly know, one of our long-time and most active members has moved to Alaska. For those of you, who don't, his name is Gerry McKee. Gerry has been active in club activities ever since its inception and has been giving freely not only of his time, but also of valuable advice and technical assistance. Since he was and still is concerned about the welfare of our club, he generously donated some of his computer equipment to the club. He gave us permission to sell it and use the proceeds to bolster our shrinking treasury.

Several members volunteered to store the equipment until it can be sold. This, of course, also has to be appreciated by the rest of the membership. That only left out the other necessary ingredient — someone to actually sell some of this equipment. Well, again our club is very fortunate to have another long-time, dedicated member to take up this task. Non other than our disk librarian, Bernie Thompson.

He selflessly used one Saturday to take some of the items and to sell them at Ace Electronics, where they had a parking lot sale. Well, he was successful and gave the proceeds of \$92.00 to the club treasury.

Thanks, Bernie for your time and effort. And, of course, thanks to Gerry for donating the items. Last, but not least, also thanks to all the people who volunteered to store any of the things until the can be sold or otherwise be disposed.

Since the editor is away, I thought I'd take the opportunity to present a short technical note which was provided by Logical Systems to make the SYSTEM files locate around the directory of double sided disks. This should work for LDOS 5.1.X, TRSDOS 6.X and was used on IS-DOS 6.3 for converting the single sided system supplied, to a double sided system optimized.

Format your double sided giving it the name of your choice in drive #1. Then enter each of the following commands and press the ENTER key when properly typed:

```
MEMORY (A="A",B=17)
BACKUP /SYS:0 :1 (S)
BACKUP -/SYS:0 :1 (I)
```

The first backup puts only the /SYS files surrounding the directory. This may be checked by the command FREE :1. The second backup adds the visible and invisible files to the inner tracks of the disk. The command FREE :1 again will show this result.

If you have any problem, mention it at the club meeting, or contact me by phone sometime. Original disks of 6.3 had a problem with DISKCOPY/CMD program when used with unformatted double sided disks. If you have not received the patch, please contact Logical Systems as they said they would issue it to all registered owners, but I have not received it except over the telephone so far.

After completing the disk creation in drive #1, put it in drive #0 and press the reset button. Enter a new time or just press the ENTER key and you have the double sided system.

Should you have more than 2 drives in your system and want to make all 4 available without a configuration file or the enable command, change the two locations of C9 on sector 2 of the disk to C3 at location 84 and 8E. Don't change any other C9's which appear on that sector (eg: 98 A2 etc). Happy computing. B. Thompson
