Model III users must first use the TRSDOS CONVERT utility. Users with only one drive must own an operating system or utility which permits single-file, single-drive copying. Model III owners have the added problem of copying from single density to double density.

This disk is a 'floppy' and is written to on both sides. Simply 'flip' the disk over to read the other side. As with all software, make a BACKUP immediately.
